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TROT MOORING USAGE PROCEDURES

- 1) The "pond" area has been divided into temporary individual trot moorings for the wet storage of Etchells competing in the International Etchells World Championship.
- 2) Each trot mooring position is marked by a white buoy with a black number.
- 3) To tie the stern off, the rope extending through the bottom of the white buoy should be pulled up until the thick mooring line with a loop at the top is reached. It is through this loop that a line should be attached to tie off to the Etchells.
- 4) Etchells are to be tied up in the following manner:
 - a. Odd numbers are to be Bow to the pontoon.
 - b. Even numbers to be Stern to the pontoon.
